CREATE A MODEL OF YOUR BIG LUNCH THAT REFLECTS YOUR NEIGHBOURS AND COMMUNITY

Can you make your neighbours out of clay, plasticine, cardboard or paper and build a model street, lane or neighbourhood from old boxes and things you can squirrel out of the recycling?

CREATE A FANTASTICAL BIG LUNCH USING YOUR FAVOURITE SUPERHEROES AND CREATURES

Will it be Batman and unicorns, wizards and fairies, mermaids and Octonauts? What kind of magic and super skills will they bring to this type of Big Lunch? Will there be potions, spells, sidekicks or signs in the sky? Or you could hold a more traditional teddy bears picnic, don't forget the tablecloth and bunting.



CREATE A BIG LUNCH WITH NATURE

Can you make a Big Lunch made up of entirely natural objects? Leaves for plates, mud cakes, twig cutlery, petal salad. What inspiration for a Big Lunch can you find in the flower beds and shrubbery? Bug Lunch anyone?

Display it in your window, on your doorstep, in the garden or outside on a wall or path for others to enjoy. You might even end up with lots throughout your neighbourhood and community. Set up a trail and see if you can spot them all!
